

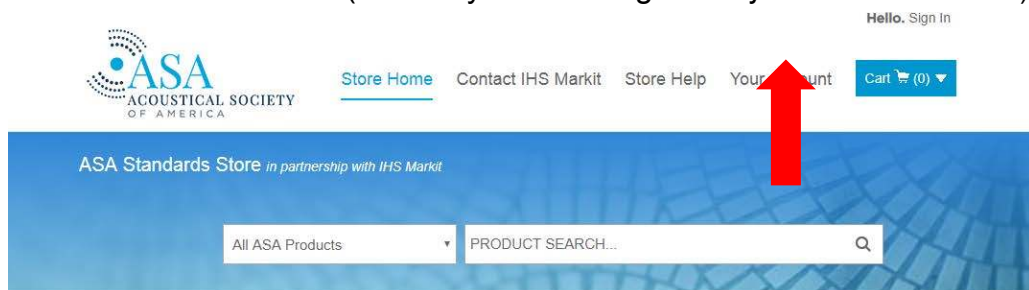
Are you an ASA Member? Let us know.

Flagging your online account as a member is easy. There are two ways to flag your account so that you can take advantage of the free and discounted standards.

NOTE: Only ANSI/ASA standards for which ASA owns the copyright are eligible for FREE download. Nationally adopted international standards (NAIS) will incur a charge of \$35 to cover royalty costs. Purchase of a \$35 NAIS will count as use of one free standard. 1. Select your membership from your account settings

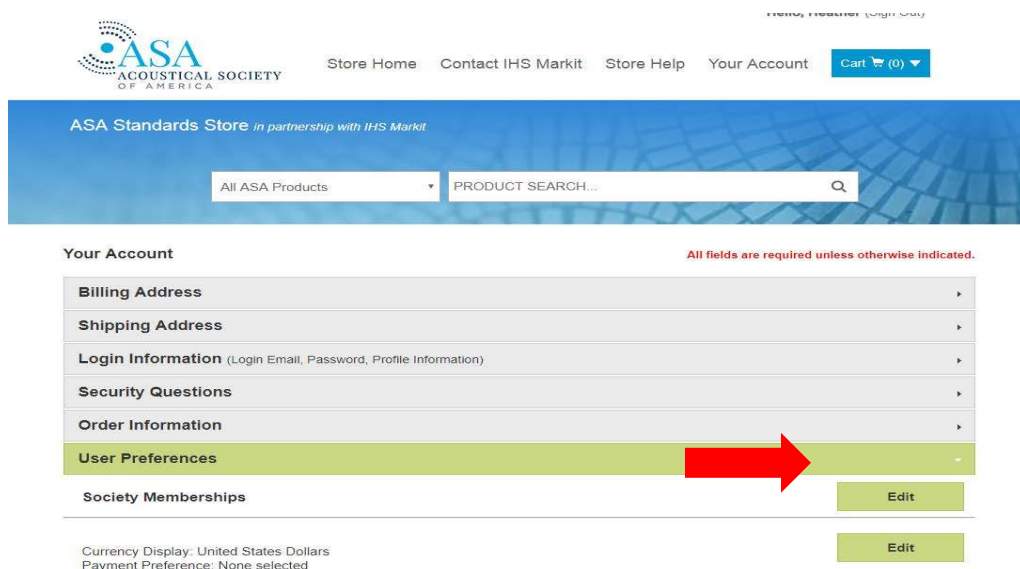
- a. Click "Your IHS Account" (You may need to register if you are new to IHS)
