



André Fiebig studied communication science and earned his PhD in the scope of psychoacoustics at the Technical University of Berlin. For more than 13 years he worked for the HEAD acoustics GmbH where he led a working group concerned with developing test procedures for sound quality applications. Since January 2019 he is a visiting professor in the Institute of Fluid Dynamics and Technical Acoustics at the Technical University of Berlin teaching psychoacoustics, noise effects and soundscapes.
