



Victor Sparrow is the United Technologies Corporation Professor of Acoustics in the Graduate Program in Acoustics at the Pennsylvania State University. He has been a Penn State faculty member in Acoustics since 1990, and he served as Director of the Program between 2010 and 2021. His research interests include physical acoustics, noise, audio, and the history of acoustics. His most recent research has focused on the sonic boom noise of future civilian supersonic aircraft, and he serves as the Research Focal Point for the United States in the area of sonic booms, under the auspices of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), a specialized agency of the United Nations.

Most recently he has been teaching Penn State courses in the areas of outdoor sound propagation, nonlinear acoustics, computational acoustics, and spatial sound and 3-D audio. He has served ASA in several different capacities, and he is a past President of the Society.
